With commercially available fully autonomous vehicles only months away, AVs provide a near-term opportunity for improved mobility and freight hauling, as well as a threat for sharply increased VMT, including zero-occupancy vehicles. Meanwhile Congress is considering federalizing AVs, pre-empting state and local action. Previous COP conversations have addressed licensing; this session will look at policy that can optimize this technology, including incentives, pricing, regulations, infrastructure, and coordination with transit. We will also hear from vanguard pilots that address some of the opportunities and threats.
